Donald W. Banner (1924-2006), a corporate intellectual property counsel, professor, U.S. Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks, and co-founder of Intellectual Property Owners Association (IPO), was known worldwide as an advocate for effective intellectual property rights. He was a mentor to hundreds of professionals in the IP community. In honor of Mr. Banner, the IPO Education Foundation awards the Donald W. Banner Corporate Intern Scholarships. The \$10,000 scholarships are awarded annually to outstanding law students who have completed an internship in a corporate intellectual property law department.

The Foundation increases awareness about corporate internship opportunities and the corporate in-house experience through its scholarship program.
